



Nakajima Atsushi is known to most Japanese because of one story, “The Moon above the Mountains,” which is included in many high school Japanese language and literature textbooks. In that sense, he is famous. Most people, however, may not have heard of his various other writings; or, if they have heard of them, they may not have actually read them.

Nakajima came from a family of Chinese teachers and scholars, and he was educated in the Chinese literary, historical, and philosophical classics. His knowledge of these areas was similar to that of such great, earlier writers as Mori Ogai and Natsume Soseki, though he belonged to a much later period. It is not surprising, then, that he should have used ancient Chinese writings as the basis of many stories, including the well-known one mentioned above.

But he also wrote works set in the ancient Middle East and North Africa, and in Central Asia. These stories, like the Chinese ones, are not just strange and exotic, but deal with basic matters in human life: Why do we live? How should we act? What meaning can we find in life?

He also wrote a novel based on the life of the great Scottish writer of the nineteenth century, Robert Louis Stevenson, and his last years of life in the South Pacific. Stevenson was a writer whom Nakajima both admired and felt close to, since the Scotsman too dealt with fundamental problems in human life, often in strange settings with interesting plots. Moreover, Nakajima also spent some time in the South Pacific in the year before his own death in 1942 at the age of only thirty-three.
