Going on an overseas trip is a great adventure, but it requires careful planning. First you must decide what country you will visit, and what season would be best to travel there. If you go to southern Italy in August, it will be very hot, and you will need light clothing. On the other hand, if you go to Sweden in February, it will of course be very cold. You will have to take warm things with you. You must keep this kind of thing in mind as you plan your trip.

Then you will have to decide whether to rely on a travel company to help you make your plans, as was usual in the past, or whether you will do it all for yourself on the Internet. For people who are comfortable using the Internet (and this probably includes most young people nowadays), it will often be cheaper and quicker to do things yourself using this most modern of methods.

Then you must decide if you will go on a package tour, travel with one or two good friends, or go by yourself. Each of these ways of traveling has its good and bad points. Traveling on a package tour is the easiest and safest, but you have little freedom and privacy. Traveling by yourself gives you both of these things, but you may be lonely sometimes, and there will be difficulties you will have to face, and solve, alone.

For most people traveling with a few good friends may be the best answer. Make sure, however, that you know your travel companions well: you will be spending a lot of time with them. By the time the trip is over, you may not be such good friends anymore!
