"Dogs are a man's best friend," or so the saying goes, but where does this idea come from? There is evidence from at least 12,000 years ago that dogs were buried in graves next to humans. This seems to be proof that the relationship between dogs and humans has been special for a very long time. Why do humans feel this bond and is it always a good idea to keep a dog as a pet? Let's explore the reasons for and against having a dog.

The first reason for having a dog is that dogs provide unconditional love.* Dogs are always happy to see their owners. Many dogs are so excited they lose control at the sight of their owner returning home from a long day. This kind of support is great if you have had a rough day. A life of loneliness can be replaced by a happy pet greeting you each time you return home.

Secondly, dogs can make owners more physically active. Most dogs need to be walked outside. This means that owners can get more daily exercise. Many people return home after work and do not go out for exercise. Dogs simply will not allow this to happen.

Of course there are reasons for not having a dog. Some buildings do not even allow pets. Also, some people live in houses that are too small and have no backyard. There might not even be a local park nearby. In these cases, it's not fair to have a dog because it will not get the necessary exercise to stay happy and healthy.

In the end, people must decide if they have the right home and lifestyle for having a dog. For many people, dogs are the highlight of their lives. Still, there are many people who are unable to have a dog because they cannot provide a proper home.
